Catalogue Note: Period-1270 Cross-Index

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A filing note that binds Observation 7A, Recovered Signal 14, Tape Series M, and CASE-1270 under a single public index term without claiming a mechanism.

PURPOSE

This note does not advance a hypothesis. It records that several public records already share a searchable index term -- period-1270 -- and that CASE-1270 is the investigation that holds them together.
